Criteria 1: Role fulfillment.

Each speaker in the debate is asked to play a specific role in the debate, something that is reflected in the mark scheme. (see the attached file)

Criteria 2: Reasoning and Evidence

Relevancy of arguments, relevant empirical evidence to support ideas, analyzed arguments from premise to conclusions.

Criteria 3: Organisation and Prioritisation

Marked out arguments, signposted ideas, internal structure, ranking of most relevant ideas, preference best ideas. Brief, the speech should be crystal clear and easy to follow.

Criteria 4: Listening and Response

Rebuttal and points of information, relevance to arguments, level of response given, prioritization.

Criteria 5: Expression and Delivery

Eye contact, hand gestures, stance, emotive language, rhetorical devices, and questions, pacing.
